If you are unable to attend and have a co-author attend in your place, the co-author will receive the award money.

As one of the top two award papers to be presented at the EOA 2025 Annual Meeting, you also have the opportunity to make a podium presentation at the AAOS Annual Meeting, March 2-6, 2026 in New Orleans, Louisiana.
